## HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Write us an email telling us why you need a mentor and from which field of expertise (if you know it).
2. Based upon your request and your areas of interests, we will match you with a suitable mentor.
3. After being introduced to your mentor (via email or Skype etc.), you will establish a working relationship and plan your meeting times.
4. Each mentee will have a mentor preferably from a different nationality.
5. The length and duration of the mentor-mentee relationship would cover an appropriate amount of time.
